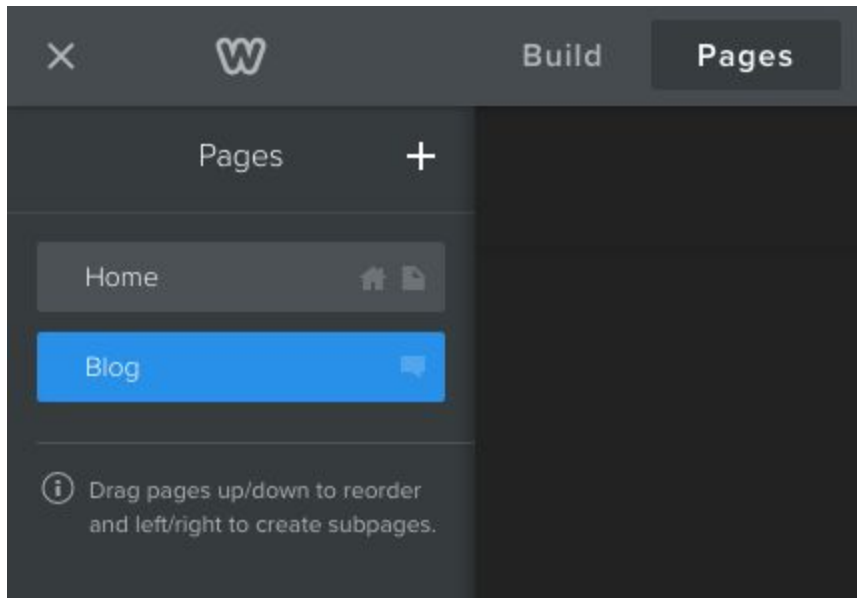


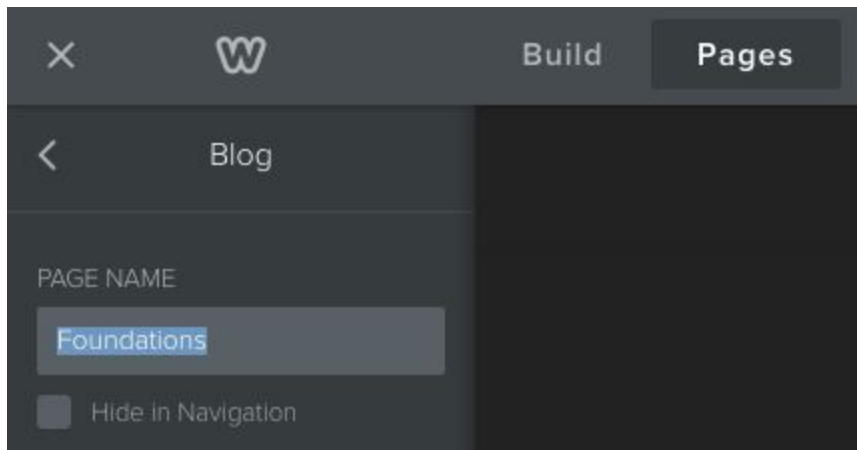

Add Blog to Site

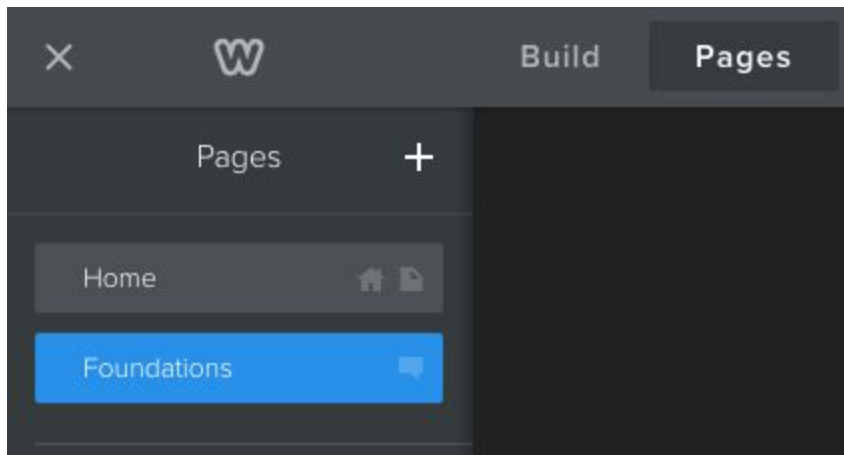
1. Log in to the Weebly you made in Foundations.
 - a. Note: Your login should be your student Gmail and your password should be either your student ID number or your student ID number and two zeros.
2. Once your Weebly is open, go to the Pages tab at the top.



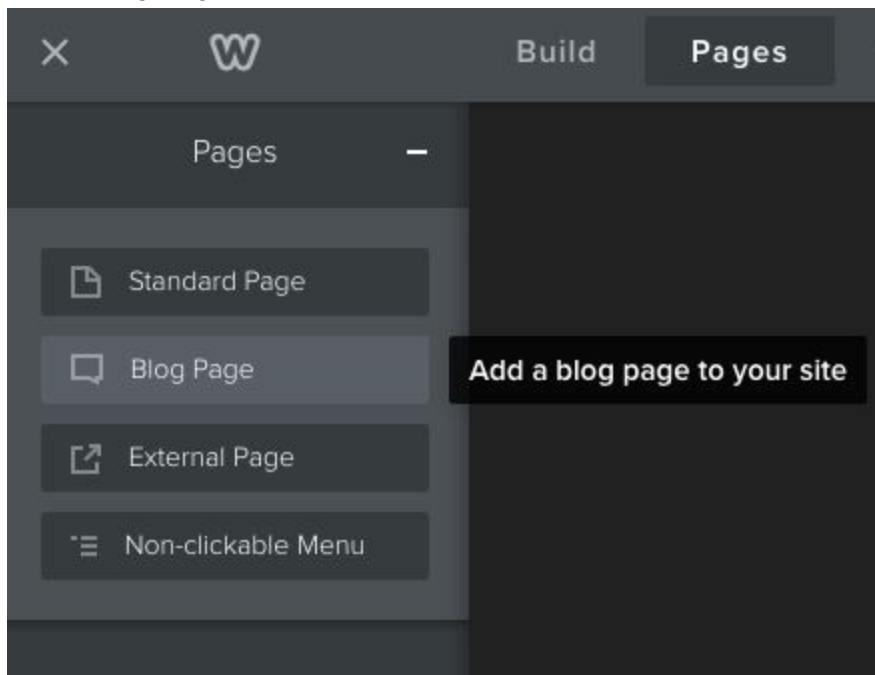
3. Select your Blog page and rename it to **Foundations**.



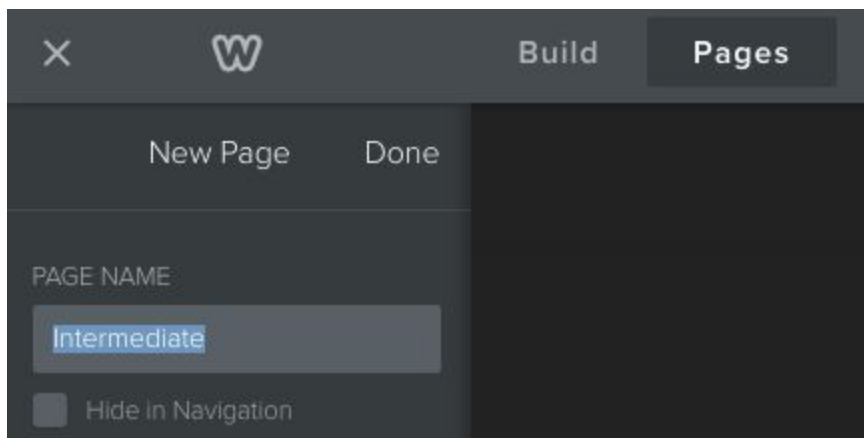
4. Click the Back Arrow until you are back to the main pages panel.



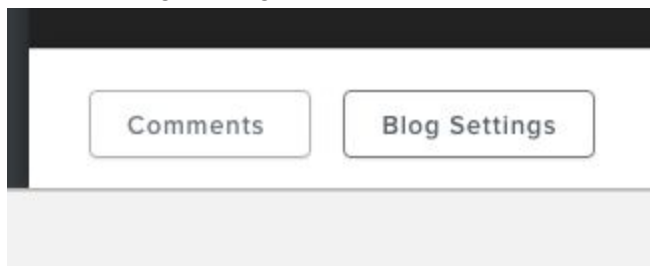
5. Click the + symbol to add a page.
6. Select Blog Page.



7. Name it **Intermediate** and click **Done**.



8. Click on Blog Settings at the bottom-left of the screen.

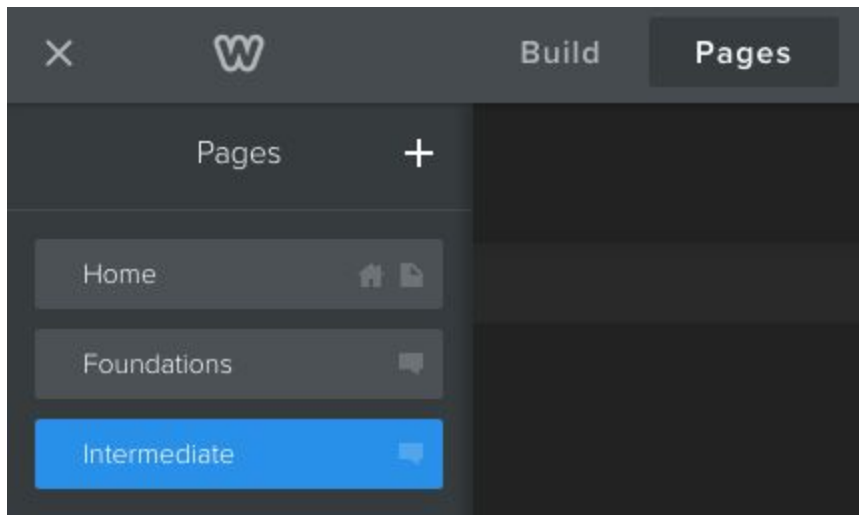

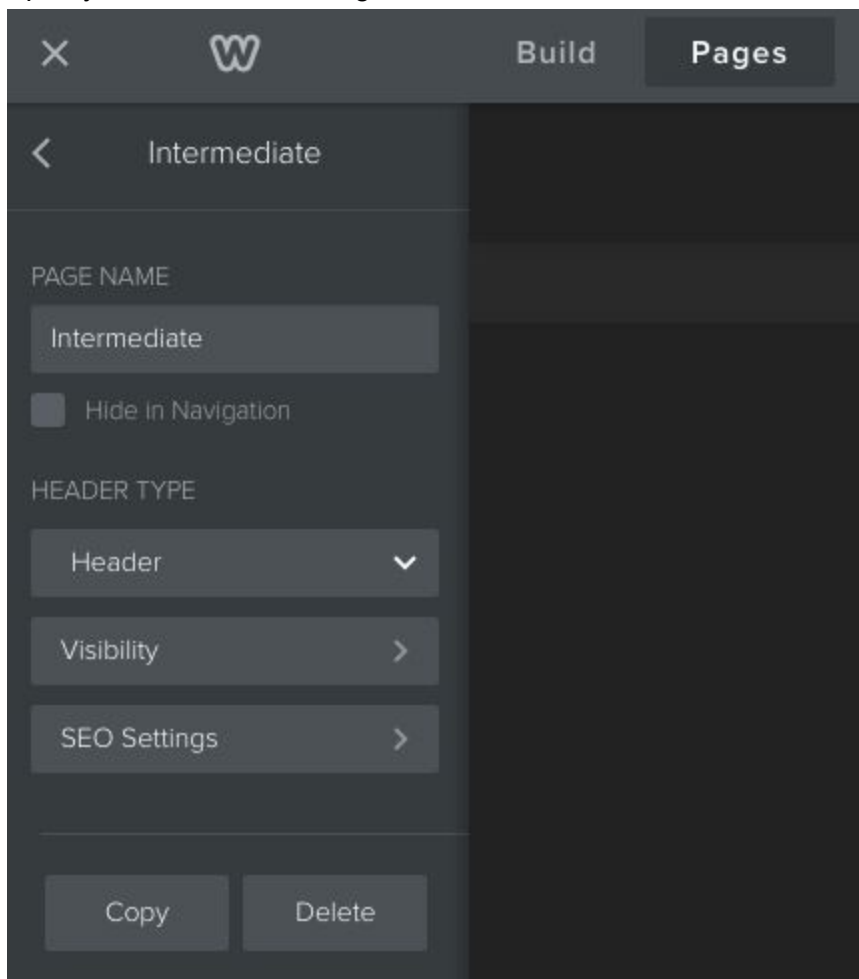
10. Click Save at the bottom right.

12. Select your Intermediate page.

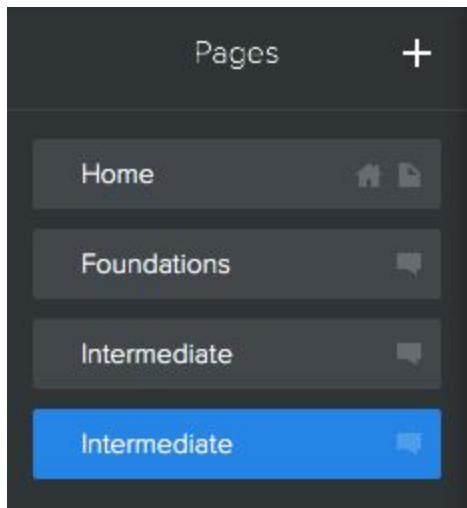


13. Open your Intermediate Page.

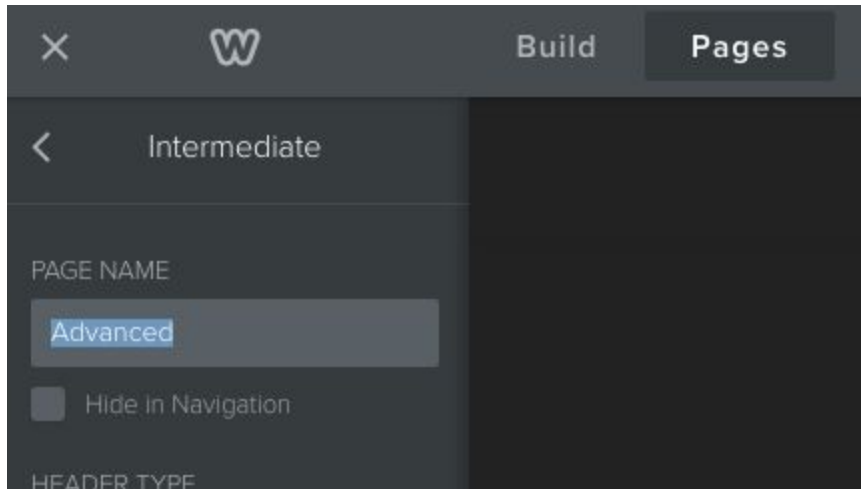


14. Click **Copy** to copy your blog.

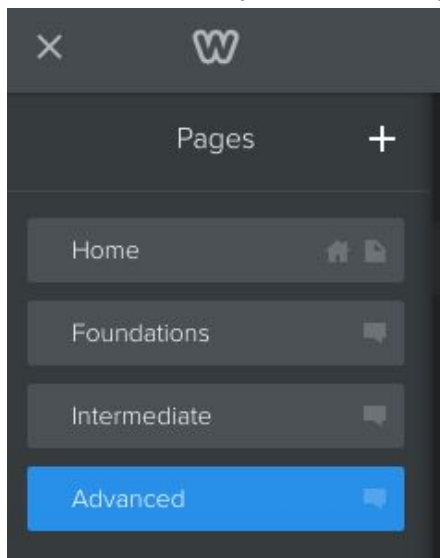
15. Now, you'll have 2 Intermediate blogs.



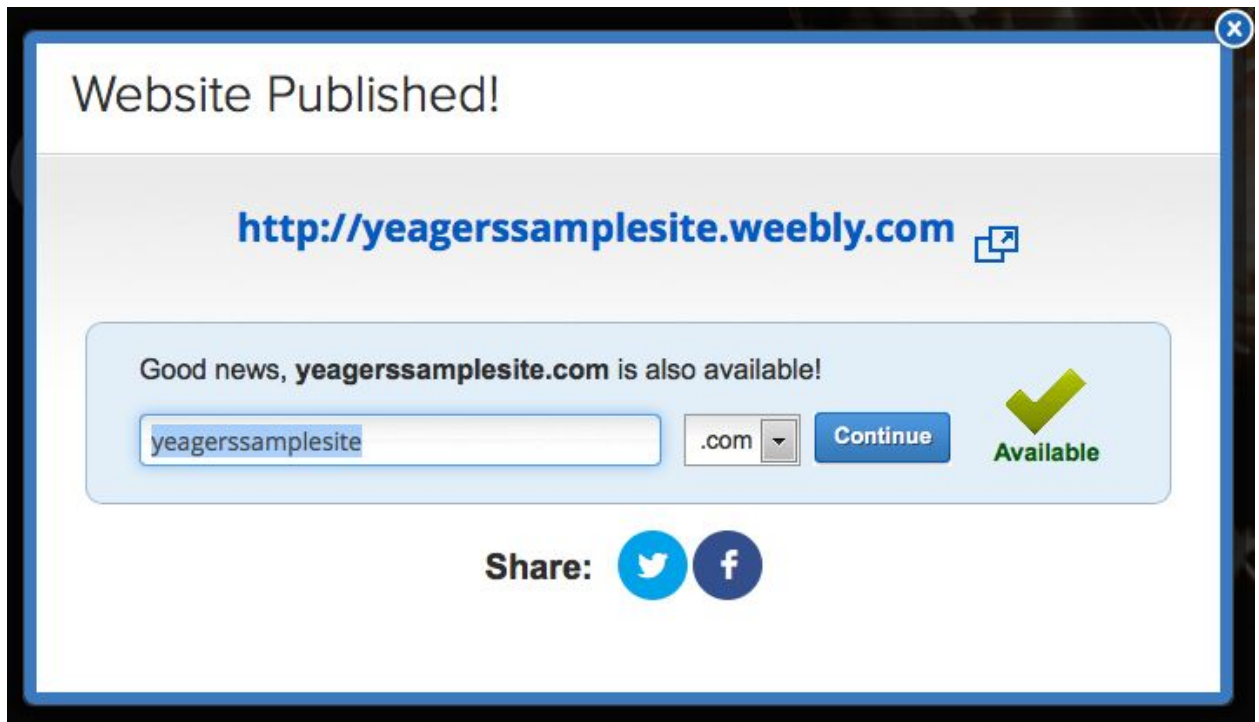
16. Click on the bottom Intermediate blog to open it, then rename it **Advanced**.



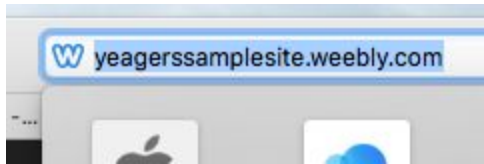
17. Check to see that you have all of your Pages.
